UTC Reading's Year 13 students are celebrating after picking up their A Level and Level 3 qualification results this morning, securing them places on prestigious degree apprenticeships and university places.

Students studying vocational qualifications achieved:

- 53% of all grades being D*D*D*DDD in BTEC L3 Extended Diploma in Engineering
- 33% of all grades being D*D*D*/DDD in BTEC L3 Extended Diploma in Computing
- 84% of all Applied General qualifications are at a pass or higher in BTEC L3 Engineering and Computing Courses

This year's results have once again secured UTC Reading students apprenticeships and degree apprenticeships with companies such AWE, Rolls Royce, Stantec, Lenovo, Royal Navy and other companies.

University continues to be a popular option at UTC Reading and this year our students have accepted offers to study STEM subjects at more than 20 UK universities including Oxford University, University of Reading, University of Loughborough, University of Bristol, UWE, Aston University, Surrey and many others.

Our vision is to 'transform lives through learning' and the journey our students have been on working alongside employers while at UTC Reading means they are well prepared for the next step.

Executive Principal of UTC Reading Wayne Edwards, said: "The students have had a very disruptive education over the last few years, and we are immensely proud of what they have achieved today and the positive destinations they are going to. I wish them good luck for the future."
